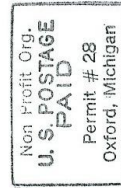

For their scheduling convenience, campers may choose from full-week camp programs, day-long activities or individual 90-minute sessions.

Campers will enjoy their days on Kingsbury's 125-acre campus, in a natural environment known for its

enriching curriculum and environmental programming.

Instructors from around the country will team with counselors from the area to create a summer program that entertains as much as it challenges.

Full-Day Camps

Theatre School (8-14 yrs) - four weeks (\$800; \$750 early registration)

June 20-July 15 (8:30am-3:30pm) - no class July 4th

Campers learn acting skills and other skills of expression while preparing for a full-stage production

All-American Lacrosse Camp (Boys 9-14 yrs) - four days (\$160; \$150 early registration)

June 27-June 30 (9am-3pm)

Campers learn skills, techniques and strategies from experienced college and professional players as provided by All-American Lacrosse

Great Outdoor Adventures (11-14 yrs) - two weeks (\$460; \$430 early registration)

Session 1: July 11-July 22 (8:30am-3:30pm) or

Campers learn orientateering and camping skills, to build shelters, cook outdoors, canoe, and more as they work up to a culminating 3-day camping trip
